KUALA LUMPUR: Deputy Sports Minister Adam Adli Abd Halim said the Universities and University Colleges Act 1971 (Auku) will eventually be repealed.

During the Dialog Anak Muda Temu Anwar today, Adam, who has been an anti-Auku activist, gave the assurance that he would do his part in the cabinet to push for the act to be abolished.

"As members of parliament, we have done our part by raising the issue in Parliament. Auku will eventually be abolished.

"We do not want the act to be repealed and replaced with something that is similar to Auku.

"We should get rid of the old legacy. Auku must be abolished, but we have a collective responsibility. We are open to talking about it," he said during the dialogue session at the Youth Empowerment Fair 2023 in the Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre here today.
