

Ex-UUM VC, ex-football ace among 10 sworn in as Kedah exco members

ALOR STAR: Former University Utara Malaysia (UUM) vice chancellor Dr Haim Hilman Abdullah and former Kedah football ace Mohd Radhi Mat Din are among 10 assemblymen who were sworn in as Kedah state executive councillors today.

Sole Gerakan assemblyman Wong Chia Zhen, who won the Kulim seat, also made into the state exco line up.

The other new faces in the line-up are two-term Pas assemblymen Mohd Azam Abd Samat (Pas-Sungai Limau) and Mansor Zakaria (Pas-Kuala Ketil).

Two first-term elected representatives from Bersatu Dzowahir Ab Ghani (Bersatu-Suka Menanti) and Datuk Mohd Salleh Saidin (Bersatu-Kubang Rotan) also made it into the list.

The swearing-in ceremony was held before the Sultan of Kedah, Al Aminul Karim Sultan Sallehuddin Sultan Badlishah at Balai Menghadap Besar, Istana Anak Bukit here.

Following the swearing-in ceremony, the Perikatan Nasional (PN) state administration has a total of 11 exco members, including Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Muhammad Sanusi Md Nor.

Seven of them including Sanusi are from Pas, three from Bersatu and one from Gerakan.

Besides Sanusi, only three exco members from the previous term were retained. They are Datuk Siti Ashah Ghazali (Pas-Merbau Pulas); Datuk Halimaton Shaadiah Saad (Bersatu-Bukit Kayu Hitam) and Mohamad Yusoff @ Munir Zakaria (Pas-Kuala Nerang).

PN secured over two-thirds majority in the State Legislative Assembly after winning 33 out of 36 seats in the 15th State Election held on Aug 12.
