

## TH donates nearly RM160,000 to help Asnaf students

KUALA LUMPUR: Tabung Haji (TH) has contributed nearly RM160,000 to the Bijak Bestari Kampung Bharu programme, aimed at improving the academic performance of asnaf (eligible tithe recipients) students and supporting the government's Kampung Angkat MADANI initiative.

In a statement yesterday, TH said the programme, which also sets out to help those from underprivileged families from being left behind in their studies, involves 100 primary and secondary school students.

TH has adopted Kampung Dato Sri Amar Diraja in Muar, Johor and presented RM40,000 to the Bakti Murni Care Centre and Surau Al-Raudah to cover management costs and facility improvements, as well as to carry out 'gotong-royong' activities in the village. – BERNAMA
